Junior Deacon/Deaconess Responsibility

Selection Criteria/Eligibility

Junior Deacons/Deaconess must have expressed a willingness to serve. They shall be at least twelve (12) years of age. Prospective Junior Deacons/Deaconess must be recommended by the Nominating Committee, the Board, an ordained Minister of the Old Westbury SDA Church, or the Head Deacons/Deaconess.

Authority/Accountability/Term of Service

Junior Deacons/Deaconess shall be appointed by and serve at the pleasure of the Church's Board. Junior Deacons/Deaconess may be appointed for a term of one (1) year. Terms may be renewed. Junior Deacons/Deaconess shall function with the authority delegated by adult Deacons/Deaconess.

Duties

Junior Deacons/Deaconess are expected to execute the following responsibilities under the supervision of the Head of Deacons/Deaconess.

- 1. Serve as Greeters before and after regular Church services.
- 2. Serve as Usher as needed.
- 3. Help with opening and closing of the church
- 4. Assist Deacons at funerals and memorial services.
- 5. Help with Set up of Audio/Video as needed

- 6. Serve as Youth Advisors at Deacons/Deaconess meetings when appropriate agenda items are to be considered.
- 7. Execute such other appropriate duties as may from time to time be called for by the Board of Deacons.

Rationale/Objectives

- 1. To provide another means of continuing the active involvement of teenagers in the Church.
- 2. To increase opportunities for youth of the Church to be involved in sustaining and enhancing the spiritual life and Christian mission of the Church.
- 3. To promote the development of future leaders for the Church.

We will ask each Junior Deacon/Deaconess to annually indicate his/her desire to serve for another one (1) year term by November 1st.
