### Health Nugget

Gout is a form of arthritis. It usually affects the big toe but it can also affect your ankles, knees, elbows, wrist and fingers. Eating a diet rich in red meat, shellfish, drinking beverages sweetened with fruit sugar increases levels of uric acid which increases your risk of Gout. Alcohol consumption also increases your risk of Gout. Joint damage can occur when left untreated. So beware of what you eat and drink and protect yourself as much as possible from this painful condition.

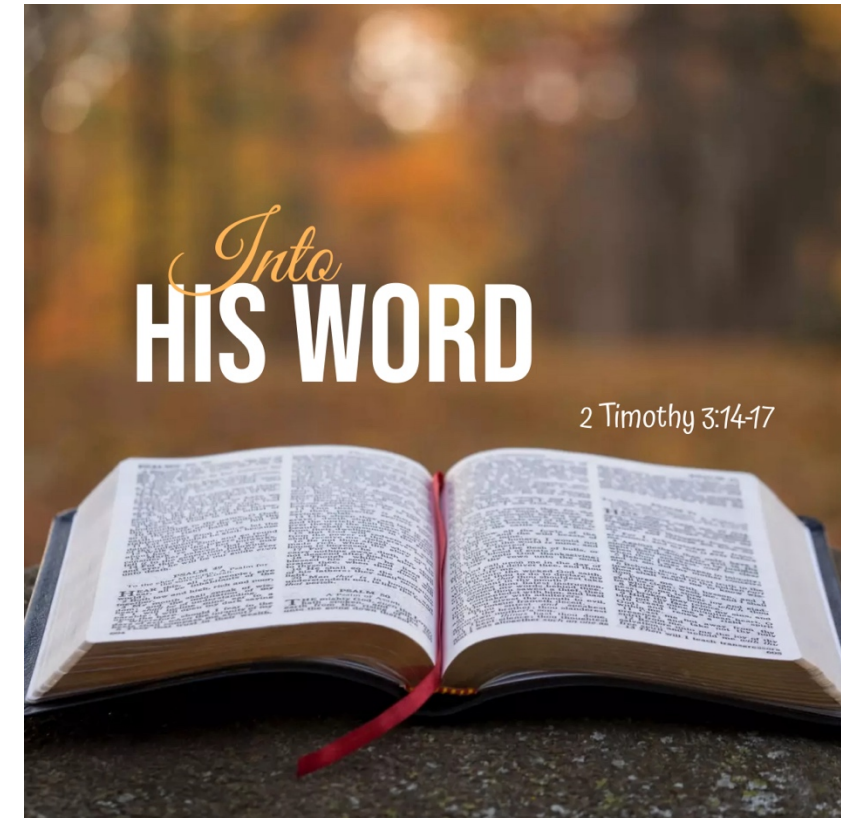
