Health Nugget

Osteoporosis is a common bone disorder that causes a progressive loss in bone density and mass. It is estimated that more than 1.3 million osteoporosis-associated fractures occur every year in the United States. Keep your bones healthy by consuming a diet rich in calcium and Vitamin D, exercising for 30 minutes a day, avoiding smoking and alcohol consumption, and by taking calcium and Vitamin D pills if you don’t get enough from food. Women greater than 65 years of age should go for bone density testing, whereas men are not tested routinely unless they have risk factors.
